The renowned KLES Arts & Commerce College located at Gadag-Betageri was established in 1985 with the efforts of the AkkanaBalaga (Local Ladies Association) and blessings of the Pontiff Jagadguru Tontadarya Math Gadag. When started, it was Women's Arts College, the only college meant exclusively for women in Gadag District. Initially the college was permanently affiliated to Karnatak University Dharwad and later in 2004 with the launching of Women's University at Bijapur, the affiliation automatically got transferred to Karnatak State Women's University Bijapur. In the meanwhile the college came under the fold of UGC's 2 (f) and 12(B) in 2003. Due to several reasons the management decided to introduce Co-Education College and accordingly got the permission of Karnataka State Govt. and approval and affiliation of Karnatak University Dharwad in the year 2011. The college is re-accredited (3rd Cycle) with B++ grade with 2.77 CGPA by NAAC in the year 2016.



The renowned KLES Arts & Commerce College located at Gadag-Betageri was established in 1985 with the efforts of the Akkana Balaga (Local Ladies Association) and blessings of the Pontiff Jagadguru Tontadarya Math Gadag. When started, it was Women's Arts College, the only college meant exclusively for women in Gadag District. Initially the college was permanently affiliated to Karnatak University Dharwad and later in 2004 with the launching of Women's University at Bijapur, the affiliation automatically got transferred to Karnatak State Women's University Bijapur.
